First Report – Election Integrity Monitoring Team  
The Opening of Polling Stations on 7/3/2010

1. Was it easy for voters to reach the polling centers?

Yes – 96.4% No – 3.6%

2. Was political propaganda visible 100 meters from the polling center, or in the polling centers themselves?

Yes – 21% No – 79%

3. Was there any fear spread in or outside the polling center with the aim of pressuring voters to vote one way or another?

Yes – 18% No – 88%

4. Did the polling center open on schedule with the all of the staff available?

Yes – 96% No – 4%

5. Did you see international or domestic observers in the polling centers?

Yes – 93.7% No – 6.3%

6. Were any observers or representatives of political entities denied entry into the polling centers?

Yes – 19% No – 81%

7. Upon opening did the staff count the voter ballots in an open manner?

Yes – 95% No – 5%

8. Were the ballot boxes locked with numbered locks?

Yes – 100% No - 0
