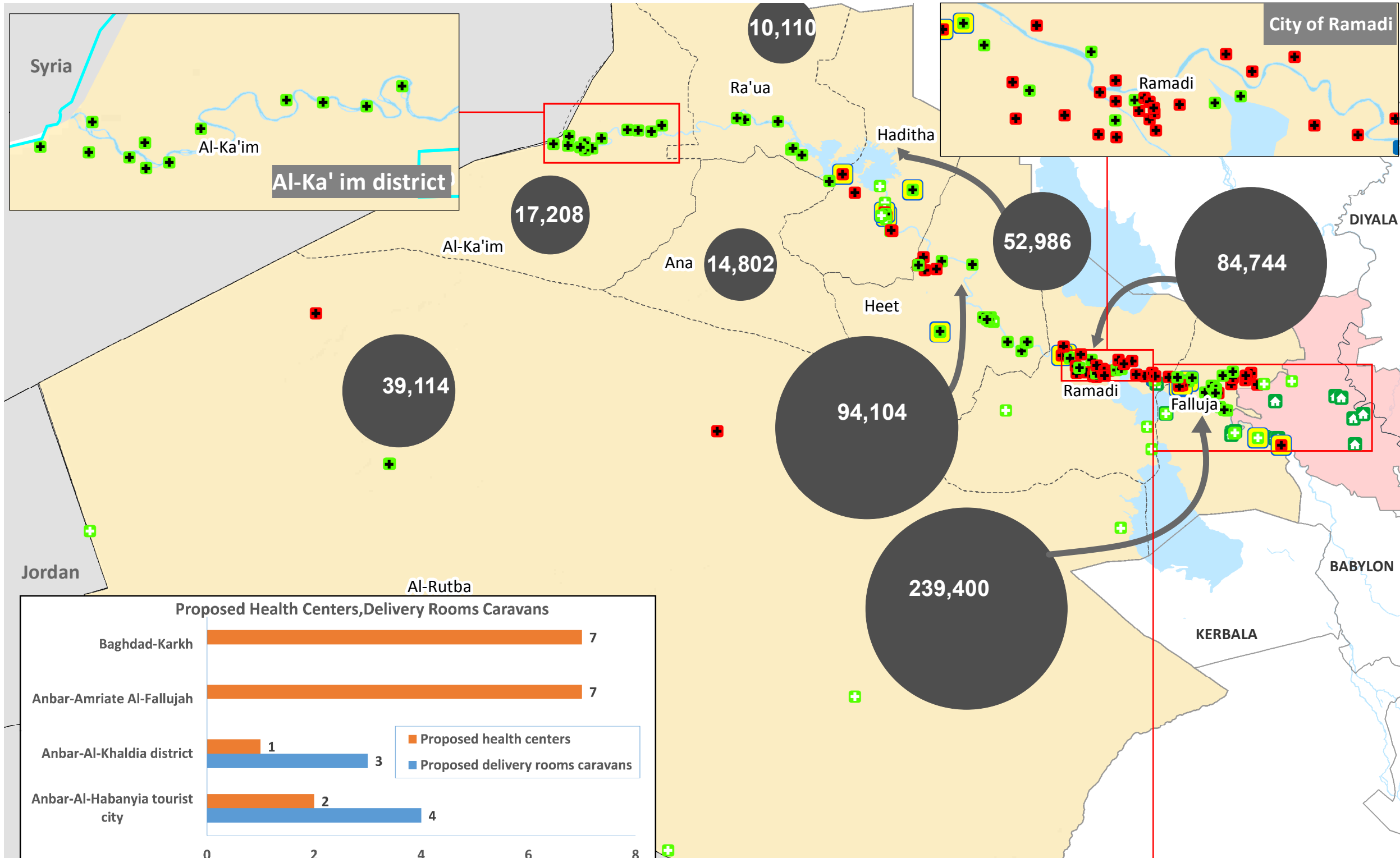


# Anbar: Health Centers and Proposed Health Centers, Delivery Rooms Caravans Locations
